## 2007 in review

Last year saw the opening of the North Head Sanctuary. On 3 January 2007 the former School of Artillery site at North Head was handed over the Sydney Harbour Federation Trust (SHFT) for the development of a sanctuary.

In March 2007 SHFT called for proposals for leasing the Former School of Artillery.

We applied for lease space under the Community Users' guidelines - nominating a focus on a range of possible community-oriented activities –

- \* Environmental and heritage study centre
- \* Native plant nursery
- \* Sanctuary outreach program.

The closing date was 8 June and we have not yet been advised due to delays in the leasing process.

## Temporary Leasing

The Australian Institute of Police Management has leased some buildings while its site at Spring Cove awaits final decisions concerning its redevelopment.

## Gatehouse Visitor Centre

On 1 June 2007 the Hon Tony Abbott MP for Warringah officially opened the Gatehouse Visitor Centre. John Moriarty gave the Aboriginal Acknowledgement of Country

## Natural environment management

The Australian Wildlife Conservancy Operational Plan for North Head Sanctuary was exhibited in July 2007. The tendering process for wildlife management has been delayed so as to advertise it internationally.

## Damage to the Arch

On 29 April 2007 an airforce truck driver managed to get stuck under, and partially demolish, the heritage listed Parkhill arch at the entrance of North Head. The arch was built in 1901 out of sandstone and was moved to its present location during the Depression. The Arch is our logo.
