Penguins not Police

Mike Baird hosted a well-attended evening regarding the proposed redevelopment of the AIPM (Australian Institute of Police Management) site at North Head.

Speakers included Kathy Ridge on behalf of our Sanctuary Foundation, Ellie Griffin, Cathy Griffin and Terry Metherell. Ellie called for action to save penguins. Terry called for the listing of Sydney Harbour and environs as World Heritage.

The discussion was lively, a whistleblower gave an insider's view of a potential tenure issue. Many people simply wanted to know how people could stop the development.

In response to a resolution of the meeting Mike Baird has sent a letter to ministers, Peter Garrett, Bob Debus, Frank Sartor and Verity Firth, requesting that the proposed development be withdrawn, the current lease to AIPM be revoked, and the property gazetted as part of the Sydney Harbour National Park. A draft letter on Mike Baird's website may be adapted if people would like to send a similar letter.
