ESBS Seed collection

On 22 October 2008 we received our Permit for collection and propagation of seeds and cuttings from ESBS at North Head.

The first set of seeds has been collected. (NOTE: It is illegal to collect seed or cuttings from ESBS at North Head without a permit.)

Some of our members are preparing a selfguided walk map with information to help you identify plants.



This photo was taken on 11 Nov 2008 from City lookout on the Gunners' walk. Can you identify any plants in the picture? Remember the red *Lambertia formosa* (Mountain Devil) from our last newsletter? There is one of them in this picture.

The white "flowers" are Flannel Flowers or *Actinotus belianthi*. Actually, the white parts are bracts - the flowers are tiny and are bunched in the centre. They grow to different heights depending on the soil and are a short-lived perennial.

Did you know that there are two types of Flannel Flowers? There is a little one called *Actinotus minor*, which is a small sprawling scrub with wiry stems. Study the picture below to see both types.
