Or Ball Honey-myrtle is a spreading prickly shrub to 3 metres tall. The flowers are yellow in dense rounded heads. The leaves are needle like and are pointed. It's now in flower on North Head and is a species characteristic of Eastern Suburbs Banksia Scrub. Usual flowering period is September to November.

Native Plant Nursery

Work has started on the second Nursery bay. Here you can see our Nursery Manager Sue Halmagyi supervising Peter Stratton, Ken Higgs and John Ellis with the construction. The wood has to be painted with three coats of Wattyl solarguard before it can be put up.



Seed collection has started and planning is under way for the planting out areas.
