Or Tawny Frogmouth is a nocturnal bird. During the day they sit upright on tree branches and blend in with the tree assisted by, their finely streaked and mottled brown and grey colouring. This Tawny Frogmouth has they fluffed out his feathers and adopted a threatening pose, notice his eyes.

Persoonia lanceolata



Or Lance-leaf Geebung is a medium shrub with lance shaped leaves eg wider in the middle. The flowers are yellow and tubular. It is in flower in summer and much of the year. After flowering, fruit form and turn from green to purple at which time it is enjoyed by birds and ants. The seed is hard to grow. It is a species characteristic of Eastern Suburbs Banksia Scrub.
