My North Head

I have now clocked up ten years as a volunteer with the Sydney Harbour Federation Trust. It has been a most rewarding adventure in so many ways. The initial volunteer selection process was a very crowded affair because of the throngs hoping to be selected. Luckily I was one of the original 50 selected. What a super learning curve we experienced. We attended Food Safety Training and two Interpretation Skills Workshops. There were numerous training days and information sessions which were great times for the volunteers. We originals were so lucky to have so much offered to us in the way of expertise and knowledge about the exceptional sites managed by the Harbour Trust.

And then there were the actual activities – running the Teahouse at Chowder Bay 2002, helping with crowds at the Chowder Bay Seafood Day 2002, being part of the 'Harbour loop' at Woolwich Dock 2003, Cockatoo Island Festival 2005, Open Day at Headland Park 2005 and various art shows at Headland Park, years of tour guiding at Chowder Bay and North Head and a stint at injecting trees at Middle Head in the Phosphite Tree Injection Program against *Phytophthora cinnamomi*. I enjoyed doing oral histories for some years of those who had previously worked on Cockatoo Island and Georges Heights and the School of Pacific Administration. I have also assisted at the Biennale on Cockatoo Island and cleaned some headstones in the Third Cemetery at North Head. I have been with the plant Nursery at North Head since its establishment in 2007.

I was on duty as a volunteer at the Harbour Trust's North Head Sanctuary Forum July 2002. My joining the North Head Sanctuary Foundation came about because of my attendance at the Forum. It was at the Forum that the North Head Champions arose and I joined this group to work for North Head to become a sanctuary. The North Head Sanctuary Foundation was born. The success of our efforts is

in evidence on the entry sign to North Head
 'Welcome to North Head Sanctuary.
 The nursery volunteers are an amazing lot.
 Capable, committed, passionate and it is a joy to
 see all the plants that have been grown from seed
 and planted out in re-establishing the Eastern
 Suburbs Banksia Scrub vegetation which once
 covered North Head.

Third Cemetery

Did you know that World War One servicemen were
 buried here during the influenza epidemic?

On 2 November 1918, the ship HMAT Medic left
 Sydney Harbour for the war zone with general
 service reinforcements but was recalled owing to
 the signing of the armistice and returned to Sydney
 on 21 November 1918 with nearly 200 cases of
 influenza, mostly of a mild type.

The following 12 servicemen died at Quarantine
 station and were buried in the Third Cemetery with
 full military honours.

- Died 23.11.1918 - Private Walter Helensworth
 Maccroanan (he was born in Scotland), aged 34.
- Died 25.11.18 - Private George Wilson Ridley, a
 married man from West Maitland, aged 19.
- Private John Henry Petherick, AIF, aged 25.
- Private Frederick Thomas Morgan, aged 19.
- Died 26.11.18 -Private Harry McKay, aged 26.
- Died 27.11.18 -Private Robert Fairley, aged 19.
- Corporal Thomas John Treacy, aged 29.
- Private James Michael Cahill, aged 28.
- Died 30.11.18 - Private Hector Fraser Hicks, aged
 18. His grave is marked and is near the gate.
- Died 1.12.18: - S/Sergeant Percy George Edwards,
 Australian Dental Corps aged 29.
- Died 6.12.18 - S/Sergeant Joseph Stock Australian
 Dental Corps, aged 32.
- Died 14.12.18- Private Alfred Ernest Brown,
 (Broadly) aged 18.
